This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term. Wherever possible, learning will be linked to our focus topic.

As **writers** we will be writing a **narrative** based on the book that we are reading, 'Mortal Engines', looking at the backstory of characters. We will be producing **newspaper** articles around our trip to **Gressenhall**, a **speech** that will be delivered to the rest of the school convincing people to sign a petition about **voting rights** and finally we will create a **Horrible Histories** inspired page.

As **historians**, we will be investigating the impact the **railways** had on the lives of Victorian people. We will also be looking at conditions in the **workhouses** and in the **cotton mills**, especially through our visit to **Gressenhall**.

As **mathematicians**, we will be investigating numerous concepts including, **percentages, shapes, algebra, sequences, line graphs and angles**.

As **scientists**, we will be deepening our understanding of **scientific change**.

Each week we will be building in opportunities to investigate, conjecture and explain the patterns we find.

As **computer scientists**, we will be finishing off our **silent movies** and programming a **Christmas snowball scene**.

As **linguists**, we will be continuing to expand our vocabulary and phrases in French around the theme of **sports** and **hobbies**.

As **musicians**, we will be further developing our skills with **recorders** and **reading and writing music**.

In **PE** we will be learning how to perform **the haka**.

In **DT** we will be making **cam toys** utilising our **woodworking** skills.

In **PSHE**, our topic will be **sex and relationship education**.
