



BRITAIN 2000 YEARS AGO

This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half-term. Wherever possible, learning will be linked to our theme of the Celts.



Our spelling will focus on revising our words learnt this year, with a particular emphasis on tricky homophones. We will write an estate agent's advert for a Celtic roundhouse, a script for a 'Horrible History'-style documentary, a spy report and a Celtic warrior school prospectus. Within these, we will revise our use of bullet points, brackets, commas for lists and co-ordinating conjunctions.

In our geographical studies, we will explain where the Celts came from and compare this to today's Europe.

Our R.E. day will involve the study of religious symbols.

In I.C.T. we will be using inputs and outputs to control Lego.

In history, we will learn about the lifestyle of the Celts, including their homes, clothing, food and music.

Our P.S.H.E. theme is keeping safe out of school.

Our focus in P.E. is athletics.

Our studies in maths will focus on fractions and solving word problems involving these; as well as revising written methods of subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be working on our factors and multiples.

In French, we will study clothing and colours, as well as looking at countries which speak French.

In science, we will be completing our study of solids, liquids and gases.
