



WHAT HAVE THE ROMANS DONE FOR US?

This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half-term. Wherever possible, learning will be linked to our theme of the Romans.



*In **English** we will be writing instructions, a commentary, a diary entry and a narrative, all based on our topic of the Romans, as well as looking at some texts and focusing on schema and inference work. We will also review our use of fronted adverbials, pronouns, inverted commas and language choices.*

*Our **R.E.** day is about the importance of belonging to a community.*

*Our **science** themes are 'sound' and 'human impact'*

*In **maths**, we will revise our mental and written methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, as well as comparing and classifying shapes and consolidating our knowledge of fractions and decimals.*

*In **I.C.T.**, we will be using Sketch Nation to create a game.*

*In **art** and **DT**, we will be creating some Roman inspired art and making*

*Our focus in **P.E.** is athletics.*

*In **music** we will be continuing to learn some pieces on our recorders and singing some Roman songs.*

*In **geography**, our focus is volcanoes and the after effects of volcanic eruptions.*

*In **history**, we will learn about the Roman invasions of Britain and compare Celtic life to Roman life.*

*In **French**, we will be learning more about French speaking countries and their traditions.*
