Year 3 Spring 1 – Ancient Egypt

This curriculum map provides an overview of what your child will be learning across the curriculum this half term. Wherever possible, learning will be linked to our focus topic.



As <u>readers</u>, we will read <u>Marcy and the Riddle of</u> <u>the Sphinx</u> and <u>Ancient Egypt – Tales of Gods and Pharaohs</u>.

As <u>writers</u>, we will write <u>recounts</u>, <u>myths and</u> <u>explanations</u>. Within these writing tasks, we will continue to learn about aspects of grammar and punctuation, especially <u>paragraphs</u>, <u>fronted</u> <u>adverbials</u>, <u>complex sentences</u> and how to punctuate <u>direct speech</u>.

As <u>scientists</u>, we will be studying <u>forces</u> and <u>magnets</u>.

As geographers, we will be studying the River Nile and why it was so important to Ancient Egyptians.

As historians, we will be learning about Ancient Egyptian society, jobs and gods.

In **DT**, we will be looking at masks and then making our own one.

As <u>mathematicians</u>, we will be learning and investigating numerous concepts including:

- Multiplying and dividing by three
- <u>Learning our 8 times tables and</u>
 consolidating our other times tables
- Multiplying and dividing a two -digit number by a one -digit number
- Adding and subtracting money

As <u>computer scientists</u>, we will be <u>coding</u>, using the program Tynker.

As <u>linguists</u>, we will be learning phrases and vocabulary in French related to <u>parts of the body</u>.

As musicians, we will be studying musical structure, rhythms and lyrics inspired by Ancient Egypt.

In <u>P.E.</u>, we will be continuing with gymnastics and forming short sequences using a variety of actions.

In <u>PSHE</u>, our topic will be 'My beliefs'.
